This project benefits the 40 children enrolled in the ECD program at the mission. This is a graduation gift for the students as they leave the program and provides them school supplies for Kindergarten.

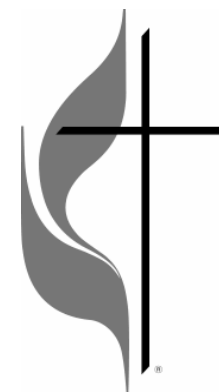
MENTAL ILLNESS RECOVERY
