Household Prayer: Morning

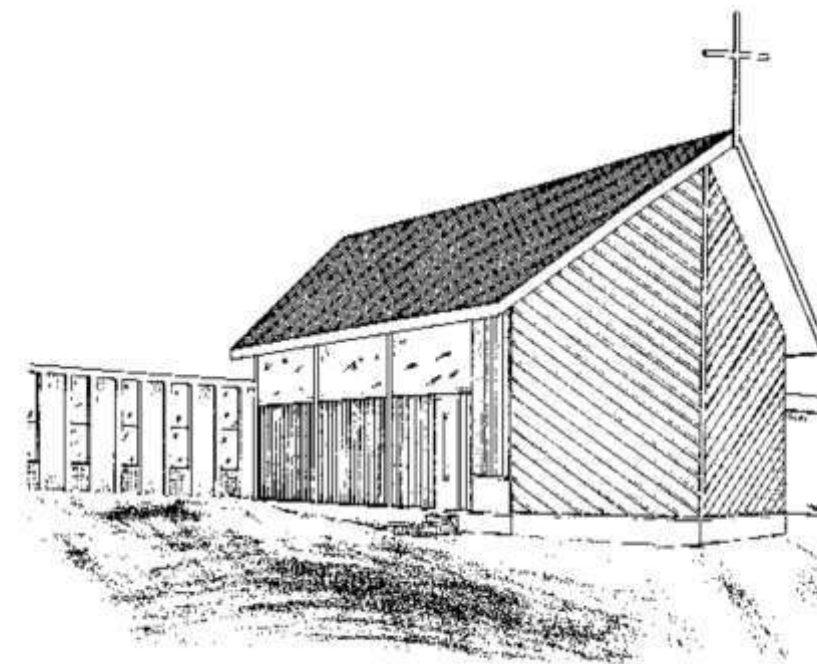
