What Can I Do?

1. Donate some of your time: help is needed on Thursday August 12th in the evening to move used clothing to the site and to begin set-up. Pick-ups especially needed to move the items from local storage on Rt. 17 to the center. Help is needed on Friday August 13th to sort clothing and set-up. Help is needed to run the event on Saturday August 14th, Monday August 16th, and Tuesday August 17th. For exact times see the bulletin board near the entrance. Wear comfortable shoes and clothing.

2. Donate goods or funds:

The following items are requested:

- USED CLEAN school age appropriate clothing (shirts, pants, skirts, jackets, shoes)
- NEW GIRLS Size 5/6 Jeans. Other sizes are also okay if you can't find this size.
- NEW White athletic socks.
- NEW school age Children's Underwear.
- School Backpacks (any type or size)
- Deodorant (any type)
- \$\$ Donations – put in the offering plate and place "SDD" on the memo line.
- All items should be placed in the mission hallway NO LATER THAN TUESDAY August 10th.
