Vacation Bible School

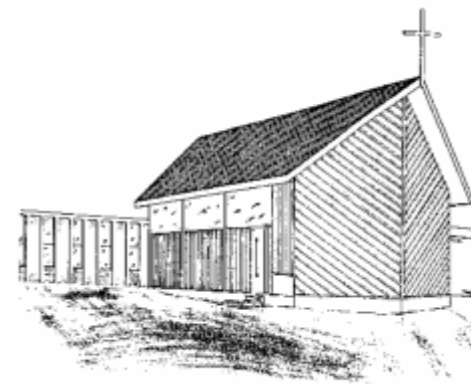
