UMW Birthing and Sewing Kits

Birthing Kits for Conference

Hotel size bar soap, one square yard of clear 4 mil. plastic sheeting, two flannelette receiving blankets each 1 yard. (Use pinking shears on raw edges to prevent fraying if you provide by the yard material).

Sewing Kits for Conference

3 yds of cotton or cotton-blend, solid color or print fabric (must be 3 yards uncut fabric), 1 pair sewing scissors, 1 pkg needles, 1 spool thread, wrap sewing notions in the fabric and place in a sealed one-gallon plastic bag.

Come join us to put the kits together on June 9th at 10am. When we finish, we will be going out to eat at Eileen's in downtown Fredericksburg. Just a reminder, this will also be out last regular UMW meeting for the summer. We will still meet weekly on Wednesday morning for our craft workshops.
