### Birthing Kits for Conference

Hotel size bar soap, one square yard of clear 4 mil. plastic sheeting, two flannelette receiving blankets each 1 yard. (Use pinking shears on raw edges to prevent fraying if you provide by the yard material).

### Sewing Kits for Conference

3 yds of cotton or cotton-blend, solid color or print fabric (must be 3 yards uncut fabric), 1 pair sewing scissors, 1 pkg needles, 1 spool thread, wrap sewing notions in the fabric and place in a sealed one-gallon plastic bag.

Come join us to put the kits together on June 9<sup>th</sup> at 10am. When we finish, we will be going out to eat at Eileen's in downtown Fredericksburg. Just a reminder, this will also be out last regular UMW meeting for the summer. We will still meet weekly on Wednesday morning for our craft workshops.
